Dear Mr. LaMountain,

Hope you are well and that this finds you all in good health and spirits. This letter is to document the ongoing technical assistance that NRCS has been providing you on your property on Mashapaug Road in Holland.

James contacted NRCS in February, 2007 to request technical assistance in planning natural resource improvement projects on the Blodgett Farm property. At that time NRCS identified the next step would be inviting a NRCS conservation planner to conduct an inventory and evaluation pre-planning site visit to review existing natural resource concerns and learn about landowner conservation objectives.

In August, 2009, James contacted the Hadley NRCS office to request the pre-planning site visit, and the visit occurred today, Monday, September 14, 2009. I witnessed the existing cleared areas intended for access roads and headquarters areas. I observed the existing soil erosion and sedimentation off of the cleared sites, and also examined the existing erosion control measures that Mr. LaMountain has installed such as water bars and detention basins.

I learned of Mr. LaMountain's plans for agricultural development, beyond the forestry enterprises currently engaged in. I laid out the process NRCS has for developing the conservation plan, that once Mr. LaMountain has the planned livestock animals onsite and there are resource concerns such as manure/nutrient management to address; that we'd be happy to develop detailed plans for improvement projects at that time.

At this time, I recommend that Mr. LaMountain resolve all outstanding natural resource issues ongoing with MDEP, and when it is settled that agricultural operations are allowed onsite by MDEP and the town, NRCS will re-engage with conservation planning for Mr. LaMountain's livestock grazing operation.

Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns that may not have been addressed in this letter. I look forward to working with you to see conservation improvement projects on the ground in Holland.

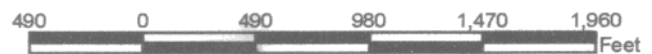

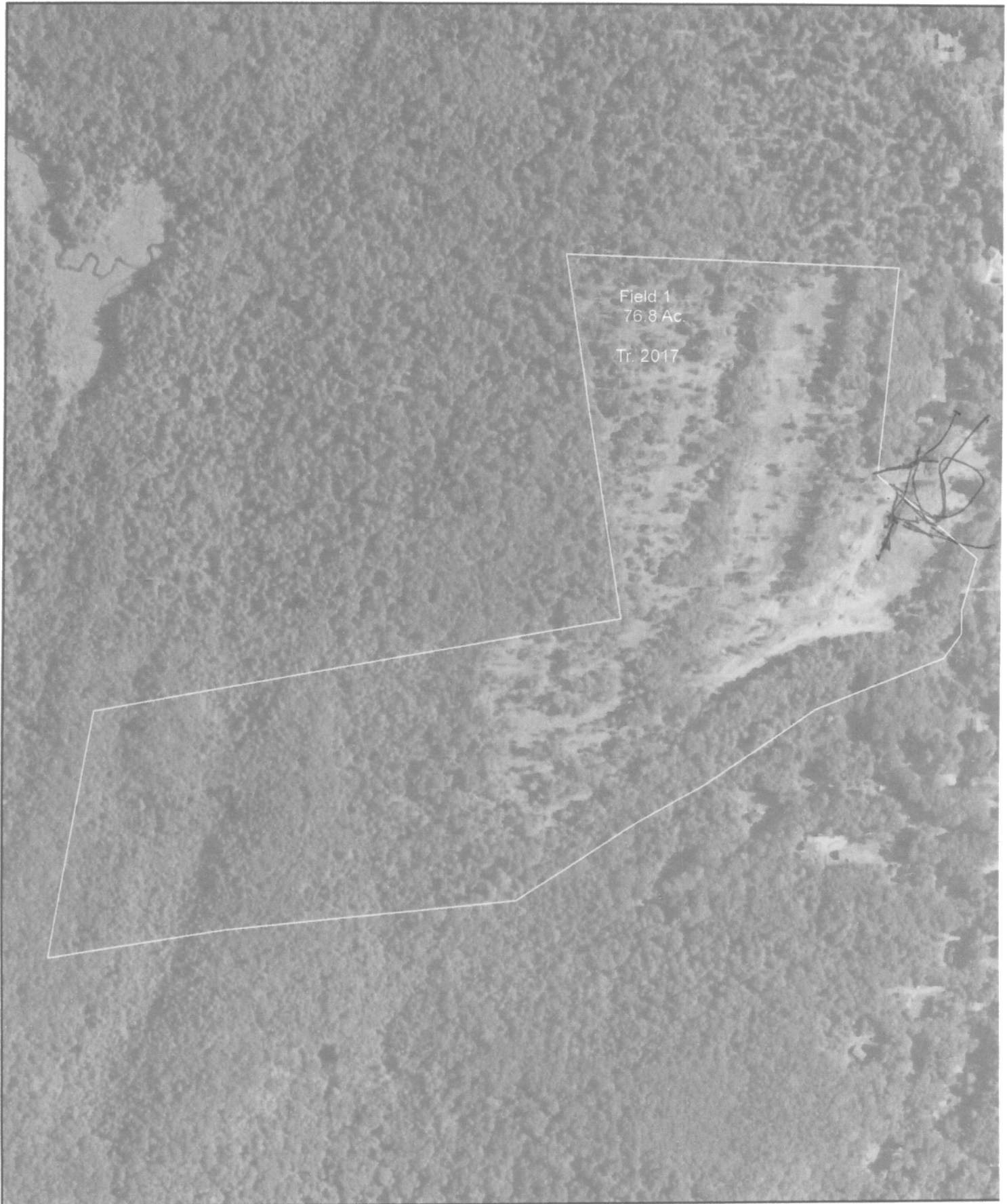
